## CHANGING & SHOWERING POLICY



As part of its commitment to provide a safe and child friendly environment for Young Children, Belbroughton Cricket Club advises that the following practices will be adhered to with regards to changing and showering:

- Players aged 10 and under will be supervised at all times in changing rooms by two members of the club of the same gender
- Adults working with young teams, including volunteers, coaches, umpires or any other official of the cricket club shall not change or shower at the same time using the same facility as Under 18 players
- Mixed gender teams will have access to separate male and female changing rooms
- If Under 18's play for adult teams they, and their parents will be Informed of the club's policy on changing arrangements and parents will be asked to sign the Parent's consent form.
- Captains are to organise use of the changing room to ensure adults and Under 18's change separately at both home and away fixtures
- If young players and adults need to share changing facilities, the parents will be allowed to supervise them while they are changing in agreement with other players and must only supervise their own children.
- If Under 18's are uncomfortable changing or showering in public no pressure will be placed on them to do so and are advised to change and shower at home
- Any person with a disability shall be communicated with, along with their carers to identify the most suitable method of changing and provide full consent to any support or assistance required
- Mobile phones are **NOT** to be used in the changing rooms
