CODE OF CONDUCT AT JUNIOR/YOUTH MATCHES AND TRAINING SESSIONS FOR PLAYERS & PARENTS/FAMILY MEMBERS

Belbroughton Cricket Club is fully committed to safeguarding and promoting the wellbeing of all of its members.

Belbroughton Cricket Club believes that it is important that members, coaches, administrators and parents, carers or guardians associated with the club should, at all times, show respect and understanding for the safety and welfare of others.

Therefore, members are encouraged to be open at all times and to share any concerns or complaints that they may have about any aspect of the club with the Club's Safeguarding Officer.

As a member of Belbroughton Cricket Club you are expected to abide by the following junior code of conduct:

- Play within the rules and respect officials and their decisions.
- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of gender, ability, cultural background or religion.
- Be positive and use positive language.
- Be honest and be ready to receive honest feedback.
- Listen to and comply with the instructions of the team coach/manager and the instructions of the team captain.
- Be a Team Player.
- Be brave, determined and cheerful In difficult game scenarios.
- Mobile phones must not be used In the changing rooms.
- Keep to agreed timings for training and competitions or inform their coach or team manager if they are going to be late.
- Wear suitable kit (box and helmet when using a hard ball) for training and match sessions, as agreed with the coach/team manager.
- Pay any fees for training or events promptly.
- Junior members are not allowed to smoke on club premises or whilst representing the club at competitions.
- Junior members are not allowed to consume alcohol or drugs of any kind on the club premises or whilst representing the club.
- When we are batting watch the game with your team mates unless giving or receiving throw downs.
- No football, rugby or any other ball games must be played at Belbroughton CC's ground other than cricket.
- No indoor cricket or catching/throwing in the changing rooms.
- When you attend any training session, work hard and practice as if you're playing in a game.

Parents and their guests/members of their family are expected to

- Support/respect all players.
- Support/respect the Belbroughton CC managers and coaches.
- Never be critical during matches or practice sessions.
- Do not coach the team or any player.
- Do not tell your son/daughter what to do in a match or at a training session -Let the manager or coach and the captain of the team do their job.
- Do not shout or give instructions to the team or any player during a match or at a training session.

If a breach of the provisions or principles of this Code occurs or is reasonably suspected to have occurred the Club reserves the right to take such action as it deems appropriate, including but not limited to asking the person responsible for the breach to leave the Club premises. Any disciplinary or complaint hearings in connection with a breach of these rules shall be dealt with in accordance with the disciplinary procedure as set out in the Club constitution or Cricket Section Regulations as may be amended from time to time.
